- Intensive experiments with few animals
- Large scale farm-situation-like experiments
- Field research on farms

Fields of research


- Animal breeding and genetics
 - The dairy cow herd is a selection experiment
 Two lines: High protein yield and low mastitis
 frequency
 - Most research based on records from national data bases

Fields of research


- Nutrition and feeding
 - Intensive experiments with fistulated cows and horses



Medium and large scale feeding experiments








Fistulated horses

- Ethology
 - Observations of behaviour both indoors and outdoors
 - Testing of alternative ways of keeping animals
 - Measurements as indicators of welfare
