## Alternatives to lab animals: where do I start looking?

Increased focus on **the 3Rs** (*Replacement, Reduction & Refinement*) in Laboratory Animal Science means that investigators, committee members and animal house staff need easy access to the resources available. Hundreds of websites have been created over the last 20 years, but it is still difficult to gain a comprehensive view of the world's best 3R resources.

Norecopa has collaborated with AWIC to produce a database of 3R resources, searchable by Type (e.g. databases, guidelines, journals, email lists), Category (e.g. blood sampling, environmental enrichment, non-human primates), 3R relevance (e.g. Refinement) and/or plain text. This new database, 3R Guide, complements two existing databases, NORINA and TextBase:
