at Oslo airport Gardermoen, 26-27 October 2017

This meeting will attract all four stakeholders in field research: regulators, scientists, industry and animal welfarists.

Implementation of the EU Directive 2010/63 and new legislation in many countries poses challenges for those carrying out field research. There are many unanswered questions which need to be discussed. One of these concerns the dividing line between capture, marking and sample collection of animals for management purposes, and for research.

A further aim of the meeting will be to close the gap between researchers working in the field and those working with laboratory animals.

Among other topics, this meeting will address:

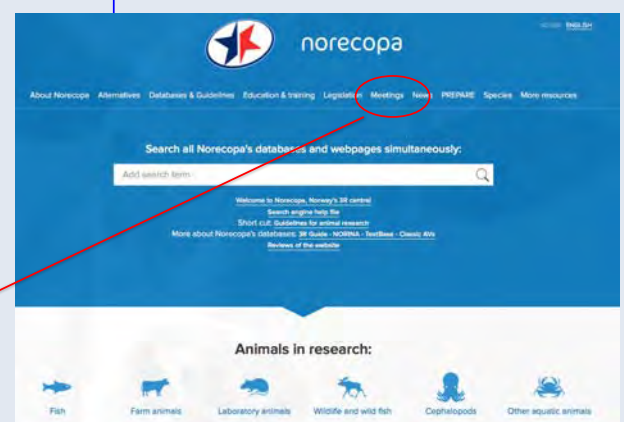
- Field research in the light of EU Directive 2010/63 EU and new national legislation
