# **The RN-SBEA in brief**

- Created in 2019
- Supported by 3 French associations AFSTAL, Gircor & OPAL
- A coordination Board with 6 members :
  - Hervé Pointu et Delphine Denais-Laliève (co-chairs)
  - Kevin Dhondt, Aurélie Eisenmann, Camille Ménard et Karim Mesbah
- A monthly meeting (remote)
- A yearly meeting (face-to-face)
- Minutes of meetings shared with the presidents of the 3 associations (transparency)
- Updated action plan











## What it does for French AWBs ?



Be a clearly identified **source of information** for the **AWB** (website, documents, guidelines,...)



Coordinate, gather and share **what already exists** (Celphedia, regional AWB networks, IDF AWB network, INRA network, etc.) and to support **initiatives** 



Be a place of exchange and sharing of experience and good practices



Set up **training initiatives** linked in particular to animal welfare and its monitoring



Work on **AWB and Ethics Committee relations** and be an **interlocutor** with official bodies (Ministries Agriculture / Research, private and public organisations, ....)

## **Achivements since 2019**

- Regular census of the French AWBs (including database update)
- Survey among the French AWBs with full report and publication in STAL
- Shared website with the RN-C2EA (network of Ethics Committees)
- Regular newsletters (n = 40)
- Frequently Asked Questions (n = 18) possibility to ask questions by email
- Practical sheets (n = 6)
- Various surveys on specific topics (own initiative or on request)
- Organization of 5 RN-SBEA conferences (half-day, before the AFSTAL yearly meeting)
- Presentations of RN-SBEA at conferences and meetings








## The idea !

- AWB was a new concept for France in 2013
- Limited guidelines in the legislation
  - Minimal composition
  - Input of the Designated vet (variable)
  - Legal missions
  - Records to be kept
- Only document available : Working document of the EC





→ But for real : how to make it work ?



### A true need

- Expressed in the survey : need for information !
- Although all the AWB missions are covered, discrepancies may exist
  - Between establishments (species, purpose, size)
  - Between AWB missions
- Need for support and tools
- Need for harmonization
- Managed as a project by Camille and Aurélie



## First, the structure




# Writing groups

- 11 writing groups based on the structure
- Each group was led by a member of the Coordination Board
- Each member of the Coordination Board was in charge of 1 or 2 writing groups
- Input of Vet Inspectors in some writing groups
- For each group
  - Virtual meetings
  - Shared document
- Once finalised  $\rightarrow$  sent to the 2 project managers



### **Recommendations for the writing groups**

- Avoid being overly prescriptive. The guide should encourage flexibility and adaptability rather than impose rigid frameworks.
- Focus on objectives over methods. Emphasize the effectiveness and performance of an AWB rather than prioritizing specific operational tools or engineering standards.
- **Craft a thoughtful content.** Clearly articulate the purpose and scope of the specific chapter, highlighting the **supportive role of AWB** and acknowledging regulatory expectations—without mandating compliance.
- Start with openness. Don't set too many limits at the beginning. If you restrict the content too early, the guide might end up unclear and not useful for real situations or user needs.


